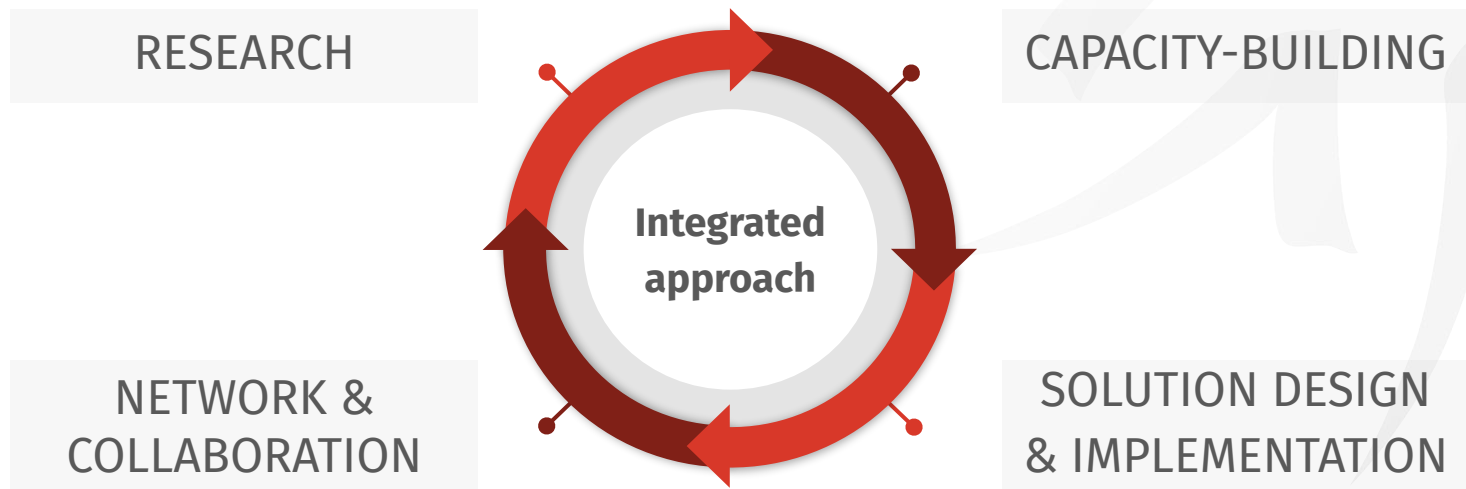

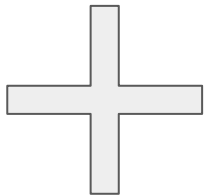

Data collaboration can be harness to:

- Improve **planning** and **service delivery**
- Enable collective **problem-solving** and **innovation**

- **how** *they are held accountable.*
